Dear parents,

Congratulations! This is our FINAL Home Practice guide this year. As we move into our last few weeks of band class, I want to update you on where your child's skill level should be in the band class. By this time, students should be able to comfortably and confidently read their notes listed on their pages (6-16) in the Accent on Achievement book. It is important that your child be comfortable with these notes, as we are transitioning from unison music toward independent parts.

If your child is struggling with these notes and has been practicing diligently at home, then you should let me know by email so I can provide special help and check for technical problems. Remember that practicing at home is the first order of getting better. Ten to twenty minutes of nightly practice is expected to achieve these results. By the Spring Concert, most students will need 20-30 minutes of regular practice. Some students do it with less time and some students may need coaching on how to practice smarter.

All 5th grade band students will participate in a final, end-of-the-year concert at Wood Canyon, Clarence Lobo, and San Juan Elementary Schools in their MPRs. Your child needs to ONLY attend the one concert that their school is scheduled below: The details of this performance are listed below. If the date assigned to your child's school is inconvenient, you may attend the alternate date. (Please send a note if you plan on the alternate date so we can keep a count of students.)
