Area Concerts

Your child will have a performance in March/April at their local high school. We call these large performances “area concerts”. These performances are **required** as part of the student’s participation in the band. Your child needs to only attend **ONE** of the concerts below. For example, if your child attended the Dana Hills High School concert on January 31st, they **do NOT** need to attend any of the concerts below. The songs that will be played for these area concerts are the district honor songs. These songs represent benchmarks for band students.

Music Grades

All students in grades 4 and 5 receive music grades during the 2nd and 3rd Learning Cycles. All music grades this grading period will be the same as the rest of the academic subjects: 4, 3, 2, 1. All students should be working toward the grade level standard(s) in music (Benchmark songs). By the end of February, your child should be able to play Claire de Lune, Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star, This Old Man, and Surprise Symphony with his/her music.
